Applicant Information Stocktake

This pānui is to let you know about an upcoming Takutai Moana applicant information stocktake, which will begin on 4 June 2026.

What is the applicant information stocktake?

The stocktake is an opportunity for Te Tari Whakatau to:

- check that we have the correct contact details for your application
- share information about the Crown engagement process and possible next steps, and
- better understand where applications are at and how we can plan future engagement with applicant groups.

The stocktake is essential to make sure contact details are current, so that we can keep you updated with key information about your application. It is also important for applicant groups to stay engaged with the Crown so that your application is considered when your coastline is progressed.

What will happen?

From 4 June 2026, applicant groups will receive a letter about the stocktake.

Different groups may receive slightly different information depending on the status of their application and any engagement already underway. This information may include:

- a form to confirm contact details
- information about the Crown engagement pathway
- contact details for a Te Tari Whakatau analyst assigned to help your group
- information about arranging a phone call or online hui if support is needed to complete the process.

What do you need to do?

No action is required until you receive your letter from us from 4 June 2026.

Once you receive your letter, we encourage you to review the materials carefully. You may also wish to begin checking that you have current and up to date contact details for people involved in your application.
