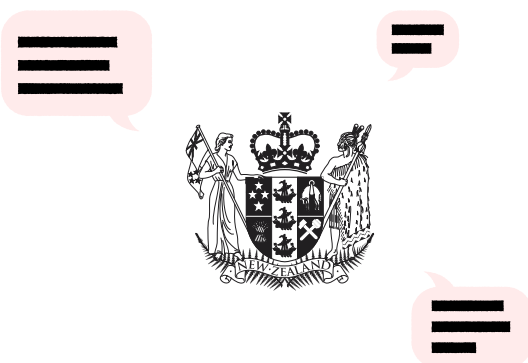

Passing settlement legislation



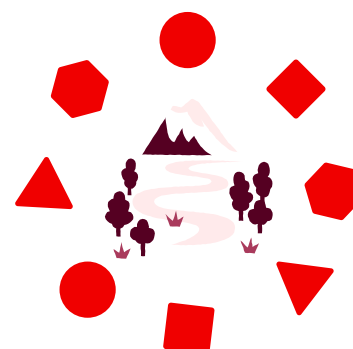
Settlement legislation enters a Parliamentary process, where it will be scrutinised by a Select Committee and will need to pass three readings and receive Royal Assent before being enacted.

The settlement legislation implements aspects of the Deed of Settlement that require legislation, and comprehensively settles the claimant community's historical Wai claims.

The time required to pass a Bill depends on the Parliamentary schedule.

Implementing the settlement



Once settlement legislation is passed by Parliament, the aspects of redress that require legislation will be vested in a Post-Settlement Governance Entity that your community has agreed to manage settlement redress.

Every member of the claimant community will be a beneficiary of the Post-Settlement Governance Entity.
