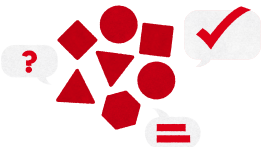


TREATY SETTLEMENT

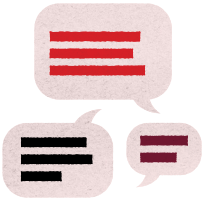

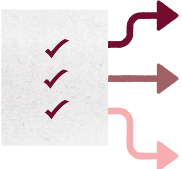
